I am sending this on behalf of the Hutton family - Quintin, Melanie (our daughter), Justice, and Verity - who are missionaries working with the Cabecar Indians in the mountains close to the city of Turrialba, Costa Rica. They are at this time during their annual Christmas celebrations, which means increased attendance in the three areas of Esperanza de Atirro, Nimari Nyak, and Grano de Oro de Chirripo. The increased attendance means more people will be under the sound of the gospel, which is the main reason for the Huttons working in these forgotten regions among a people who have been practically forgotten by government and society. There was a great need for God's provision to take care of the food, goodies, and toys that would be distributed during the celebrations. GOD SUPPLIED THAT NEED!! PRAISE AND GLORY BE TO HIS NAME!! Those who helped with this project have an eternal investment in the souls of these dear children. (see attached photo)

HUTTON PERSONAL NEED. By the grace and mercy of God, the Huttons were finally able to rent a home after they had been told to move by their former landlord. After much searching and praying, the Lord provided a former Air B&B house (around 30 years old) at a phenomenal monthly rate. The house is furnished but still lacks a few items such as a dining room table and chairs, and now, Melanie tells me, a new stove. The existing stove just gave up the ghost and almost caused a fire! WHEN IT RAINS, IT POURS. With all they have on their plate - the ministry in the three areas, the celebrations (There are two remaining. The first was a great success, with several professions of faith in Christ!!), home schooling the kids, moving to another house, etc. etc., this last problem of a broken-down stove just doesn't add to the settling of the nerves.

I asked Melanie how much a stove would cost, even though it might be a Costa Rican brand. She responded, between \$700 and \$800. I assured Melanie that God is faithful, and that he will provide. Please help us pray that the Lord will raise up what is needed to help the Huttons with the dining room table and chairs, and now THE STOVE. We need your help and prayers. For those of you who know Melanie and Quintin, you know that they are tireless workers whose hearts are focused on reaching the Cabecar Indians with the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ - WHO IS THE REASON FOR THE SEASON.
